SPAY/NEUTER ASSISTANCE

Millions of adoptable but homeless dogs and cats are killed annually in the U.S. In some years nearly 1,000 are killed here locally at our animal control facility. Spaying and neutering is the best way to put an end to the senseless killing of these animals.

To make spay/neuter surgery more affordable, we offer **financial assistance** for qualifying families. A copy of our financial aid application form is available on our website.



We also offer **free transportation** for anyone who wants to take advantage of nearby low cost spay/neuter services. The transport to Margaret B. Mitchell Spay/Neuter Clinic in Bristol, VA leaves from the Wytheville municipal parking lot on the first Thursday of every month. We must have at least 15 dogs and/or cats for each transport. Your help with achieving our monthly goal is greatly appreciated.
