Tales with Tails provides fun and interaction with pets at the Wythe County Public Library's weekly story time for preschoolers. At local elementary schools, kids work on their reading skills with dogs and get their own book about a therapy dog.



Friends WYTHE K9s & Felines works with the Wythe County Dog Shelter and the Wytheville Cat Shelter to help find owners of lost/stray dogs and cats or find rescues or adopters when owners are not found. Our goal is to help reduce the number of lives lost in our local shelters. We raise funds to help with flea/tick treatments, vaccinations, vetting, and any transport or boarding fees that may be needed when getting the animals to rescues. We also take donations of collars, leashes, crates, toys, food and treats. Volunteers visit the shelters daily to walk the dogs and give the animals treats and attention.

Our Barn Cat Program places cats from the Wytheville Cat Shelter with families who will let cats live in their barns. WBAWL takes care of vetting and spaying/neutering.







While WBAWL does not have a rescue program, we help folks network animals that are lost, found or in need of rehoming through **Facebook** and **Petfinder**. Our long term goal is to eliminate homeless animals through spaying and neutering.

SPAY/NEUTER ASSISTANCE

Millions of adoptable but homeless dogs and cats are killed annually in the U.S. Spaying and neutering is the best way to put an end to the senseless killing of these animals.

To make spay/neuter surgery more affordable, we offer **financial assistance** to qualifying families. A copy of our financial aid application form is available on our website. We also offer financial aid to any Wythe or Bland County resident, regardless of income, for spaying/neutering a feral cat. Feral cats must be in a trap and will be ear tipped.



We coordinate **free transportation** for anyone who wants to take advantage of nearby low cost spay/neuter services. Thousands of dogs and cats have received low cost surgery through this program.

The transport to Margaret B. Mitchell Spay/Neuter Clinic in Bristol, VA leaves from the old Wytheville recycling center, across from King's produce, on the first Thursday of every month and returns the next day. A reservation is required.
